



Fly-A-Ways RC Club

New Member Orientation

Effective June 1, 2016

The following is required to become a new (first time) member of Fly-A-Ways:

1. Read the Field Rules & AMA Safety Code. These documents can be found in the “Info & Application” section on the club website at www.flyaways.org and hard copies are also posted on the bulletin board in the kiosk at the field.
2. Contact and make an appointment to meet at the field with one of the club Ambassadors listed below.
3. The Ambassador will meet with you and review the Field Rules and AMA Safety Code while orienting you with the physical aspects of the field and Fly-A-Ways flight protocol. This meeting can vary in time depending on how well you understand the requirements. A typical meeting might be approximately 30 minutes. The Ambassador will try to ensure that you understand the requirements of membership in Fly-A-Ways. The Ambassador will also ask if you need basic flight training. Fly-A-Ways currently offers training for fixed wing aircraft only.
4. After the meeting the Ambassador will notify the Club President, Vice President, Secretary, & Treasurer that you have completed new member orientation and are approved for club membership. The Ambassador will also notify the flight training coordinator if you need basic flight training.
5. Make a dues payment:
 - a. You may pay on-line using the on-line payments link in the “Info & Application” section on the club website at www.flyaways.org **or**
 - b. Pay by check. Fill out a membership application. This document can be found in the “Info & Application” section on the club website at www.flyaways.org and hard copies are also in one of the plastic holders on the kiosk at the field. Mail your completed application with a check for dues to the name and address on the application form.
6. Your membership application will be processed and you will receive a Fly-A-Ways membership sticker that must be applied to the back of your AMA membership card. You will also receive the combination to the lock on the gate and the user ID and password required to access the “Members Only” page on the club website. Please allow up to 3 weeks to process your member application.
